



**Sarah Jackson** has held the position of Piccolo for the Los Angeles Philharmonic since 2003. Previous orchestral positions were as a member of the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra in British Columbia, Canada, where she held the position of Second Flute, later followed by Assistant Principal Flute and Piccolo from 1993-2003. During this time, she taught at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, where she insisted that her students tackle the piccolo as well as the flute in their studies. Sarah Jackson is a much sought after piccolo and flute teacher, attracting students from across North America.

An active chamber musician, soloist, clinician, and freelance artist, Ms. Jackson has played for numerous films, CD recordings, and TV and radio broadcasts. She toured extensively and has frequently performed as soloist on both flute and piccolo in Japan, the Czech Republic, Canada, and the U.S.

Sarah received her Bachelor of Music Degree in Flute Performance from the University of British Columbia in Vancouver where she studied both flute and piccolo with Camille Churchfield, former Principal Flute with the Vancouver Symphony. Sarah attended McGill University in Montreal, Quebec for Graduate Studies with Tim Hutchins, Principal Flute of the Montreal Symphony.
