

Greater Portland Flute Society Study Grant Parent Financial Application

The purpose of this Study Grant is to financially assist young flutists to secure ongoing private musical training. The award is based on financial need, ability and promise. Eligible students must be in high school or middle school, with at least one year of flute performance with a musical group or private teacher. The recipient(s) will be awarded financial assistance to pursue private study with a GPFS flute teacher. In addition the recipient(s) will receive free membership in GPFS, discounted admission to GPFS sponsored events for one year and the use of a flute(s) if one is not already available to them. There will be three scholarships awarded this year.

No audition is necessary, however both the student application and this parent financial form must accompany a letter of recommendation from the student's current music teacher or music professional.
