Alaina Goff started playing the flute as a fifth grader in 2021-22, and has been the principal flute in the Straub Middle School Advanced Band since sixth grade. Studying with Sandy Norman in Salem, Oregon, Alaina was selected to the OMEA All-State Middle School Honor Ensemble in 2024. She was chosen for the Salem All-City Middle School Band in 2023 and 2024, the latter as a section leader.

Arwen Danzmayr is in 8th grade at West Sylvan middle school. He played flute about a couple years, but stopped for a while. When he moved to Portland about a year ago, he started studying the flute again with Dr. Sydney Carlson. "I've been enjoying learning with her. I participated in Oregon all state band last year and it was a fun experience."

She now studies the flute with Martha Long. Marilyn plays flute, piccolo, and alto flute in the Portland Youth Philharmonic's Conservatory Orchestra and Wind Ensemble, and saxophone and flute in her school's jazz ensemble, where she has won four outstanding soloist awards for both instruments at jazz festivals over the past year. In her spare time, Marilyn enjoys reading, swimming, and long outdoor walks with her dog.

Olivia Sun has been playing the flute since she was in fourth grade at Valley Catholic Music School. She participates in her school band and Valley Catholic's Flute Choir. She studies the flute with Beckie Hocker.

She started in elementary school band and quickly began to take lessons from Sue Gillespie, and is currently studying with Sandy Norman. Throughout her high school career, she served as the principal flute of the Corvallis Youth Symphony (CYS) and the Oregon All-State Symphony Orchestra. She has also participated in various honor ensembles, including the Western I Band Clinic Firebird band and the All-Northwest Symphony Orchestra. She was the 2022 CYS concerto competition winner, the Oregon MTNA 2022 and 2023 alternate, and the OMEA district 11 solo flute competition winner for three years in a row.

Ayush Wynkoop attends Valley Catholic High School in Beaverton and is in his seventh year playing the flute. He studies the flute with Beckie Hocker. He plays in the Symphony Orchestra and Symphonic Wind Ensemble of the Metropolitan Youth Symphony. He has played in the Westside Community and Youth Orchestra in Hillsboro and the Valley Catholic Flute Choir Flutissimos. He also plays saxophone. He says - "I am grateful for the human and cultural connections enabled through being involved in music, and I plan to major in music performance."

Meghan Whitaker is a freshman at Grant High School, and has been playing flute for 6 years. She studies the flute Heidi Jones. This is her first year with the Portland Youth Wind Ensemble. She also enjoys playing the piccolo and alto sax.

She is a member of the Valley Catholic School band, orchestra, and flute choir, and performs with the Portland Youth Wind Ensemble. Emily Wen is junior at Sherwood High School, the principal flute of the Sherwood High School Wind Ensemble and Portland Youth Conservatory Orchestra, and has been playing the

flute for 6 years. She has played in wind quintets, flute ensembles, and more. Emily studies the flute with Denise Westby.

Jingtong Yu is a freshman at Catholic Valley High School. She has been playing the flute for three years and has studied with Beckie Hocker since the seventh grade. She is first-chair flutist in her high school band and plays in the Portland Youth Wind Ensemble. Some of her repertoire has included Ballet and Dance of the Blessed Spirits by Christoph Willibald Gluck, Concerto in C Major for Flute K. 299 by Mozart, and Romance Op. 41 by Georges Brun.
